The work was considered important enough to be translated by order of the French Academy " (Zeitlinger). Lavoisier's treatises appeared first in 1783 in the Transactions of the Paris " Académie des Sciences."

A very rare book, consisting of an entirely alchemical commentary to Christophe de Gamon's "Trésor des Trésors," an alchemical poem by a 16th century poet (see Jocher-Adelung II, 1328, and Brunet II, 1476). Caillet mentions "6 miniatures symboliques," no doubt in error, as these miniatures occur in a MS. of the same text in the de Guaita catalogue (no. 506).

A very interesting copy, interleaved throughout, and profusely annotated by a 19th century adept, whose rubber stamp "J. Dumas" is on the title-page.
