Fine copy of this famous book which first appeared "anonymously, or pseudonymously, or rather Euonymously," at Zurich in 1552. It is interesting as a record of the chemistry known by Gesner, the greatest naturalist, polyhistor and bibliographer of his time. It deals with distillation and is the forerunner of the books of Glauber and French, as it is the successor of those of Brunswick and Ulstadt. It gives an account of plants to be distilled (with drawings of them), of furnaces and other apparatus, and the methods of getting the virtues out of plants, animals and minerals, and other uses in effecting cures. It contains some singular remedies and some curious ideas. Ferguson I, 315.

When Gesner died in 1565, he left one of the earliest and most accurate autobiographies with a full description of 72 works already written and a list of 18 more still unfinished or unpublished. This is in the form of a letter written to William Turner, the great English botanist, and it begins on leaf 20 verso. Only a few copies of this edition were printed for Gesner's friends. Gesner did not seem to know the date of the first edition of his *Thesaurus Euonymi* for he quotes 1558 as the first edition, and he was not sure of the French translation 1555.
