This extensive collection covers the most important works published on the subject during half a century. Most of the contributions are by British and German authors, there are also a few French and one Swedish author represented. The majority of the items are presentation copies to Smithells and carry messages to him by their respective authors. The lot also contains some of Smithells' own publications. Of especial interest is a paper by Fritz Haber, *Experimentelle Untersuchungen über Zersetzung und Verbrennung von Kohlewasserstoffen*, 1896.

It should further be mentioned that one of the volumes has a copy of a 1818 edition of Sir Humphry Davy's treatise on the *Safety Lamps for Coal Min ers*-this is interesting because Smithells' own work on flame proved that, in the main, Davy's old theory of luminous flames is correct. Aside from these printed papers there are further two ALS by J. S. Haldane. Two of the volumes show Arthur Smithells' signature on fly leaf. Some have autograph notes of his inserted.

It should be impossible to duplicate a similar collection today, many of the items being very rare.
